

# Essendon Quilters Quilt In 2019: Bits and Pieces Challenge

Take your bits and pieces  
Using fabric that's small,  
Make a mini or a project for show  
It may be useful or just for the wall  
Make it fast, or make it slow  
Using any technique at all  
Stitch by hand or machine  
Embellishments will make it shine  
Decorative stitches are more than fine  
The requirements are just below  
And enter our "Bits and Pieces" show,

Our 2019 challenge is to take those bits and pieces of fabric that all quilters possess and make either a mini quilt or a three-dimensional work or collection (of works).

You may enter a work in both categories.

In making your work or works you may use any quilting technique and use any form of decorative stitching or embellishment. It can be stitched by hand or machine. If you use or vary a commercial pattern you will acknowledge the copyright owner.

## Size requirements

Mini quilt – The mini quilt must be 20 inch by 20 inches or the perimeter of the work is equal to 80 inches.

Three-dimensional works – Your work or collection (of works) must fit into an enclosed square box that is 5.5 by 5.5 by 8.5 inches deep.

## Viewer's Choice

There will be a Viewer's choice award for each category. Quilt in attendees will have a single vote for each category. In the event of tie the winner will then be drawn randomly.

## Entry Cost

You can enter one or more works or collection of works for the small amount of \$5.00.

## Return of Entries

Entries will be available for collection at the completion of the Quilt In.

## Other Frequently Asked Questions

**Can my mini quilt have 3 dimensional elements?** Yes, you can use fabric manipulation or folded piecing techniques or similar attachments.

**Why do I indicate design source?** Essendon Quilters may use images of your work on our website or Facebook or Instagram pages. This allows us to comply with copyright laws.

**Do I have to have my work in any future Essendon Quilters activities?** No. We understand that your work or works may be a gift. If you say yes on the entry form, we will contact you if there is an opportunity using the details you provide. You can make up your mind to participate knowing what the opportunity is.

	<p><b><u>Original Design:</u></b> Applies when no other person has any claim on the design. It is all your own work – you have not used or been influenced by a quilt, art work, or photograph of another person.</p>
	<p><b><u>Traditional Design:</u></b> Applies when traditional blocks have been used that are regarded as being 'in the public domain'. You have made the choices of fabric, colour and layout settings for the quilt.</p>
	<p><b><u>Version of Someone Else's Design:</u></b> Applies if you followed someone else's pattern but made your own fabric choices and perhaps made variations to the design. You must name the designer and / or publication where you obtained the design.</p>
	<p><b><u>Someone Else's Design:</u></b> Applies if you have followed someone else's pattern and fabric choices. This includes Kits and Block of the Month designs where fabric and pattern are provided and used as directed. You must name the designer and / or publication where you obtained the design.</p>
	<p><b><u>Influenced By:</u></b> Applies to artwork or a quilt seen in an exhibition, or a picture in a calendar, or anything over which another person can claim copyright, and permission has been obtained. You must name the designer and / or copyright holder.</p>
