

# ROSE'S QUILT BASTING SERVICE - FLAT RATE

LOCAL FLAT RATE MACHINE BASTING SERVICE TO SANDWICH YOUR QUILT TOP, BATTING AND BACKING FABRIC TOGETHER, IN PREPARATION FOR EITHER HAND OR MACHINE QUILTING.

Large basting stitches are machine tacked either vertically or horizontally on your quilt. These stitches can easily be removed as you progress your quilt. All layers are held taut while being basted thus reducing the risk of bunching. Each row is densely basted at approx. 3 – 4 inch intervals. For a 70" x 90" quilt this is **equal** to 500+ safety pins.

#### THIS MEANS:

- No glue
- No spray
- No pins
- No fuss

#### WHY MACHINE BASTE YOUR QUILT?

- you don't like glue or spray fumes
- you don't have access to a large surface to baste your quilt
- your arthritic joints prevent you from pin basting
- you are short of time or simply don't enjoy basting your quilt

#### RATES

Quilt Size*	Flat Rate
1-19 sq feet	\$45.00
20-34 sq feet	\$55.00
35 - 44 sq feet	\$65.00
45 - 55 sq feet	\$75.00

\*To calculate the size of your quilt (in square feet):

1. Measure the length and width of the top of the quilt in inches
2. Multiply the length by the width
3. Divide that figure by 144. This gives the total quilt area in square feet

#### THE FINE PRINT

To ensure these rates can be maintained, the following criteria needs to be met:

- Customer to drop off and to pick up their quilt at my home in Niddrie or to organise and pay for postage
- The batting and backing must be 10" wider and longer than the quilt top. This excess fabric allows the quilt to be loaded onto the frame and to be basted to the edge.
- Backing fabric must be cut square to ensure the quilt sandwich is square to the frame.

Please note, basting stitches will be done in yellow thread for visibility.
